The Board has reviewed the business plan at regular intervals and developed the Risk Management Strategy which encompasses laying down guiding principles on proactive planning for identifying, analyzing and mitigating all the material risks, both external and internal viz. Risks emanating from uncertainties in the global market place and growing complexity in the value chain are cited by most as the important factors contributing to increased risks. The gist of the regulatory developments across various countries including India is that the Boards have been tasked with the onerous responsibility of ensuring alignment between strategy, risks, rewards and executive compensation. While the Company has more or less formalized Risk Management roles and responsibilities, risk governance processes would require considerable attention if the Company has to leverage Risk Management as a driver of enterprise value.

#### 1 BACKGROUND

Mcon Rasayan Pvt Ltd ('the Company') was incorporated on September 22nd, 2016. The company is carrying on the business of Manufacturing and Reselling of Water Proofing Chemicals, Construction Materials and Paints.

### 2 STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES & OTHER NOTES TO ACCOUNTS:

#### a) Basis of accounting and preparation of financial statements:

ii) Stock in process is valued at cost including directly identifiable related overheads.

ii) Cost of inventory comprises all costs of purchases, duties & taxes (other than those subsequently recoverable from tax authorities) and all other costs incurred in bringing the inventory to their present location and condition.
