# Dhananjay Munde's 'gang' devastated sarpanch's family: Jarange

Maratha quota activist Manoj Jarange on Thursday accused the 'gang' of Maharashtra minister Dhananjay Munde of devastating the family of Beed sarpanch Santosh Deshmukh, who was murdered last month. Jarange alleged that the group, including Munde's associate Walmik Karad, is focused solely on making and exploiting money in politics.

The remarks came after Santosh Deshmukh's brother, Dhananjay Deshmukh, met Jarange in Beed on Thursday, a day after Karad was remanded to the custody of a Special Investigation Team of Maharashtra police. "The gang of Dhananjay Munde



has devastated the family of Santosh Deshmukh. This gang will be under a curse for this crime," Jarange said. Minister Munde has been facing calls for resignation from the

opposition, supported by ruling BJP MLA Suresh Dhas, due to his links with Karad. Jarange further criticized the group, stating, "The gang of Munde doesn't understand humanity. It only cares about making money from politics and playing politics with money. Some gangs are also protesting demanding the release of the accused (Karad). The acts of such gangs are tainting the state's image."

The murder has gained a caste-related dimension, as Santosh Deshmukh was a Maratha, while most of the accused belong to the Vanjari community, which is dominant in the Beed region. Speaking about the investigation, Dhananjay Deshmukh said, "We just want the inquiry to be done properly and justice served."

# Saif Ali Khan attacker identified; police investigation underway

Bollywood actor Saif Ali Khan was stabbed multiple times by an intruder inside his Bandra apartment in Mumbai around 2.30 am on January 16. The attacker, identified as part of an attempted burglary, entered via the fire escape staircase. Khan sustained six injuries, including two major ones, with a significant wound to his thoracic spine. He underwent surgery at Lilavati Hospital, where Dr. Nitin Dange, a neurosurgeon, confirmed that Khan is out of danger and in recovery.

Deputy Commissioner of Police Dixit Gedam stated, "One accused has been identified. He used the staircase to enter, and teams are in the field to arrest him. So far, the investigation suggests it was an attempted burglary."



Ten detection teams are working on the case, and the police are probing all angles, including a possible connection to the Bishnoi gang, but no arrests have been made yet.

Reacting to the incident, Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis said, "The incident must be taken seriously. The government will take steps to

make Mumbai safer."

The attack occurred at Khan's 12th-floor residence in the Satguru Sharan building, where he lives with his wife Kareena Kapoor and their sons Taimur and Jeh. Reports indicate that the intruder was heading toward Jeh's room when the maid's screams alerted Saif, leading to a scuffle. The assailant fled the scene.

Political leaders, including Mamata Banerjee, Aadiya Thackeray, Supriya Sule, along with film personalities like Chiranjeevi, Jr NTR, Neil Nitin Mukesh, Pooja Bhatt, among others expressed shock over the attack on Saif Ali Khan and raised concerns about safety and law enforcement in Mumbai. Many wished for Khan's speedy recovery and called for improved security measures in the city.

## Delhi govt initiates drive to trace those not claiming Ladli Yojana benefits

NEW DELHI. The Women and Child Development (WCD) Department of the Delhi government has launched a targeted initiative to ensure girl children enrolled in the Ladli Yojana, a flagship financial assistance scheme, receive their dues. The campaign focuses on tracing beneficiaries who have either not claimed their payments or failed to renew their applications.

Introduced on January 1, 2008, the Ladli Yojana aims to uplift girl children born in the national capital by offering term deposits at key milestones. These include Rs 11,000 for hospital births, Rs 10,000 for home births, and Rs 5,000 upon enrollment in classes one, two, six, nine, and ten. A WCD department official revealed that nearly 1.86 lakh individuals enrolled in the scheme did not claim the benefits, while 1.66 lakh applicants either

dropped out of school or did not renew their registration. "Many children change districts for schooling but do



not renew their registration under the scheme, often due to a lack of awareness. Others discontinue their education midway, further complicating the renewal process," the official said.

In response, officials across Delhi's 11 districts have been directed to compile

annual reports identifying beneficiaries who have not renewed their applications. These reports will be shared with schools to locate the students. "If the students are found, their renewals will be processed. If not, the lists will be shared with other districts for further tracking and coordination with schools," the official added. The initiative also involves centralising operations through the Ladli branch headquarters, which will reconcile reports, monitor fund utilisation, and manage financial adjustments such as budget allocations and unutilised fund surrenders. The campaign coincides with a growing number of beneficiaries under the scheme. In 2022-23, 64,408 girls were added, with the figure increasing to 72,425 in 2023-24. Officials hope the drive will ensure that the scheme's benefits reach every eligible girl child in Delhi.

## Panel formed for judicial probe into Beed murder case

The Maharashtra government has appointed two single-member judicial committees for separate inquiries, officials said on Thursday.

Retired high court judge M. L. Tahaliyani will lead an inquiry into the murder of Beed sarpanch Santosh Deshmukh. The committee will investigate any individual or organisational responsibility for Deshmukh's death, assess police and district administration actions, and recommend measures to prevent similar incidents, as per the government order issued on Wednesday. A second panel, led by retired judge V. L. Achalia, will investigate the custodial death of Dalit protester Sonmath Suryavanshi in Parbhani. The inquiry will examine the events leading to Suryavanshi's death, police handling of the situation during related violence, and accountability of officers involved. Suryavanshi, 35, died in a state-run hospital on December 15 while in judicial custody after being arrested following protests over the desecration of a Constitution replica. Both committees are required to submit their reports within three to six months, the order stated.

## Mumbai-Ahmedabad bullet train corridor begins electrification

The electrification work for the Mumbai-Ahmedabad Bullet Train corridor has begun, with the first two steel masts erected



on the viaduct at a height of 14m from the ground level in between Surat- Bilimora Bullet Train Stations in Gujarat.

In total, over 20,000 masts, ranging from 9.5 to 14.5 meters in height, will be installed along the corridor. These masts will support the Overhead Equipment (OHE) system, including overhead wires, earthing systems, fittings, and associated accessories, forming the complete 2x25 kV overhead traction system for the MAHSR corridor suitable to run Bullet train. Promoting Make in India policy, these OHE masts conforming to Japanese standard design and specifications are manufactured in India and would support the overhead traction system for high-speed trains.
